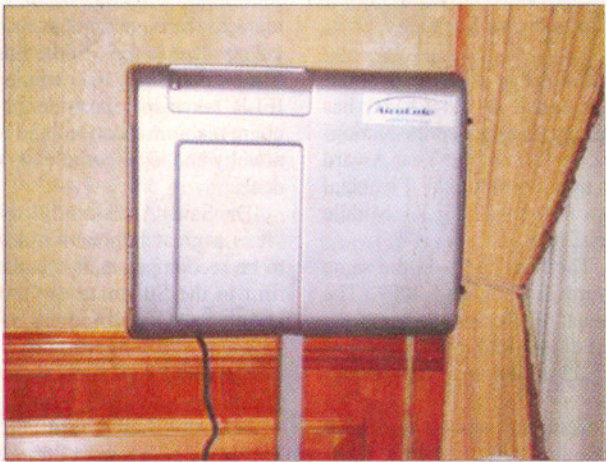


AT A GLANCE ...
